Jesus said,

‘You shall love the lord your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.’

This is the first and greatest of all the commandments. Saint Catherine of Siena, a Mystic and Doctor of the Church, saw surrendering to God's love as our purpose in life. And she considered surrendering to God's love a life time activity. St. Catherine's use of the word surrender is significant. To surrender means to: give up completely a course of action, or a way of thinking. Our purpose in life is to surrender any course of action which prevents us from accepting and returning God's love. However surrendering is difficult, because original sin has flawed our human nature. Original sin influences us to stubbornly hold on to: fears, disbelief, false ideas and harmful fantasies. We are easily tempted to fear divine and human love, rather than embrace them. Our flawed human nature keeps us from simply accepting the gift of God's love and being joyful about it. And so, it takes a life time to achieve our purpose in life---surrendering to God's love so we can love God with our whole heart soul mind and strength. We are a gifted people because in the Divine Plan we were chosen to be loved by God, and created able to return God's love. Jesus, the Good Shepherd keeps us firmly in his care. We belong to him. We are his. Nothing has the power to snatch us away. Surrendering begins by saying : Jesus I trust in you.

final event, for these 40 days, is a potluck dinner on  
6:30 PM, Monday, Nov. 7, at our nearby Our Lady  
of Peace, in Santa Clara. This will be followed by  
a candlelight ceremony at the shrine.

Your support doesn't really need to conclude  
now. Thoughtful notes & resources are provided to  
continue support. Let me know if you wish to get  
on the list. In the last few years, this program has  
saved more than 4,300 lives from abortion, led to the  
conversion of 52 abortion workers and the closure  
of 13 abortion facilities.

Also, you can pass the word to others about this  
program. This is an on-going coast to coast joint ef-

## DISTRICT DEPUTY REPORT

October was a busy month here in District 20. All of our Councils either conducted or prepared for the Tootsie Roll Drive. Formally called our Campaign to Assist People With Intellectual Disabilities, this annual project of the



Knights of Columbus has grown and matured over the years to be a major part of the assistance we

provide to those in need. Some of our Councils provide the contributions to Special Olympics, others to special education classes at our local schools. In any case, all contributions are sincerely appreciated, as is the time that the Council members contribute to take up the collections.

Some of the contributions we receive come from our own membership through the 365 Club. There has been a little bit of confusion over this effort and I will try to simplify it for all of us. The 365 Club represents one penny per day for the year as a donation from a member to Columbian Charities. The confusion usually comes on how to get the \$3.65 from the member to Columbian Charities.

The Financial Secretary of a Council mails dues notices each December to the members. Many of our Councils include a line on the dues notice for the 365 Club and the total amount a member sends to his Council depends on whether the member voluntarily – a key point I will discuss in a moment – checks off the 365 Club box and includes that amount with the Council dues. Then, the FS will account for the dues as a credit to the Council accounts and the \$3.65 as a debit that will be sent by a Council check to Columbian Charities by the deadline before the annual State Convention.

The check to Columbian Charities is not mailed. Rather the Grand Knight delegate to the State Convention will bring it with him to present at the Parade of the Grand Knights on Saturday.

I mentioned above that the 365 Club contribution is voluntary, and since it is such Councils should not include it in their annual dues. The voluntary contribution should be identifiable on the dues notice. The Council can also include other voluntary contribution items such as Wheelchair Foundation, St Juan Perez House, or the House of Formation here in San Jose Diocese. These are all worthy causes that many of the Councils in the diocese do support, and offering the opportunity to contribute to them to the membership is certainly a worthy thing to include in the annual dues notices.

Good luck to all of our Councils with the PWID drives. Remember to mail in donations you collected in October and November soon to meet the legal requirement that contributions collected publicly are sent within 30 days of receipt.

And a very happy Thanksgiving to all of you and your families.
