**CHAPLAIN'S COLUMN**

**“YOU ARE MY BELOVED”**



Listen to the voice calling you “Beloved”. The most important moment in the public life of Jesus was his Baptism in the River Jordan, when he heard the affirmation---“you are my Beloved on whom my favor rests.” At this moment, in a profound way, Jesus is reminded who he is. His temptations in the desert

were temptations to move him away from that identity. In the desert Jesus was tempted to believe he was someone else.

You are the one --- that can change stones into bread.

You are the one --- who can jump from the temple.

You are the one --- who can make others bow to your power.

Jesus said, no, no, no. I am the beloved Son of God. The whole life of Jesus was claiming that identity. There were times when he was praised, and times when he was despised or rejected --- but he kept saying: “I am the Beloved Son of God”. All of our temptations, in some way are enticements away from our true identity as beloved children of God. Like Jesus, we must say no, no, no that is not who I am. My Baptism affirms me as a beloved of god. All of our life we need to listen (in prayer) to the One who constantly calls us back to that true identity. We should not listen to our false and deceitful ego---telling us: we are what we do, or we are who people say we are, or we are what we own --- no! I am not what I do. I am not what people say about me. I am not what I have. Our life is rooted in the spiritual identity created in our soul at conception and affirmed at our Baptism, when God said to us: you are my beloved child. As flawed humans we will always be enticed away from who we really are. The temptations of Jesus remind us of the continual temptations we must withstand during our life. We are not what society deceitfully says we are ---and we are certainly not what we do. Listen, to the voice who calls you “Beloved”. Enter into communion with the One who loved you before you could love. The first letter of John reveals our first love. We love because God first loved us.

## DISTRICT DEPUTY REPORT



Things are moving along as they usually do at the beginning of the Columbian Year. District 29 continues to grow as each of the four Councils holds recruiting drives. Some are pulling in several candidates

to contact some only a small number or even just one. But any is a welcome addition. As each Council determines the quality of the contact, it is time to start scheduling First Degrees to initiate the candidate to membership in the Order.

Several very important steps need to occur soon after a First Degree. First, the Council Financial Secretary needs to make sure that the Form 100, properly signed by the Grand Knight, the candidate, and the FS is submitted to Supreme. This should be done the next day by putting the signed copy in the mail to Supreme. A copy of the Form 100 should be given to the Field Agent and the copy should be delivered to the FA immediately after the First Degree. Finally, the Report of First Degree must be filed. This is a revised Form 450C and can be executed by the District Deputy, the GK or the FS. Please coordinate who will file the form.

These three pieces of paperwork serve very different but useful functions. The Form 100 copy to the FA allows the FA to schedule an initial visit with the new member. This is not an insurance sales pitch. Rather, the FA provides background information about the Order and introduces a lot of the family concepts to the new member and his family. The Form 100 to Supreme establishes the new member information in the Supreme Membership database and indicates if the new member is an insurance or associate member. This is very important as it is counted in the Council growth goals for the Columbian Year. The Form 450C has an added function this year as Supreme will be using it to track a Council participation in First Degrees, a new requirement for Star Council this year.

So keep up the good work on recruiting and make sure to complete the paperwork!

The other big activity this month is the Tootsie Roll Drive, or the Columbian Foundation Drive for People With Intellectual Disabilities. I am gratified that all the District 29 Councils are participating

again this year, as they always do. Good luck with all your efforts.
