CHAPLAIN'S COLUMN

DO NOT BE AFRAID

The old and new Testament consistently cries not to fear, because fear imprisons, paralyzes, and fear disheartens. The Prophet, Jeremiah shares a conviction he held, which enabled him to overcome his fears. "the Lord is with me like a mighty champion," {jer.20:11} in the tenth chapter of Matthew's Gospel, Jesus speaks to all fears, large and small, reasonable or unreasonable. Three times he says, simply, "do not be afraid." the Gospel assures us of the attentive and caring love that God lavishes on everyone. "do not be afraid you are worth more than many sparrows." Jesus tells us that God knows the flight plan of every sparrow; and is so aware of all humans that every hair on every head is numbered. However, God's knowledge and care does not free humanity from suffering or fear. Jesus' own path to glory passed first through suffering, but not without the comfort and support of God's Divine presence.

At his agony in the garden, as Jesus began his journey to Calvary, he reached to a place inside where he was being held in love. In times of fear all of us have a place inside where we, too, are being held in love. God will direct our fear to create what he wants us to be. Trust God. Jesus did. In times of fear cry out as Jeremiah did, "the Lord is with me like a mighty champion." We must not allow ourselves to be disheartened, paralyzed or imprisoned by fear. Because we believe in God's Divine word, which assures us, not to be afraid. You are worth more than many sparrows. Even the hairs of your head are numbered. The struggles of life are passing. They vanish. The joy God's love gives our souls will never vanish. It lives forever within our soul in the kingdom of God. Have no fear for what tomorrow may bring. The same loving God who takes care of you today will take care of you tomorrow and every day. God will either shield you from suffering or give you unfailing strength to bear it. Be at peace, then, and put aside all anxious thoughts and imaginations.

CULTURE OF LIFE REPORT

A point of information this month: Several of you brothers have asked about our Supreme KofC Ultrasound Initiative for the Juan Diego Society (JDS). This is truly a great program -- I have a cousin that is involved with financing support for one in the LA area. I have talked

to Willie, of JDS, about this. Unfortunately, there are several complications here. 1st, JDS does not have the volume to justify an ultrasound on their own. Then, it is not just the cost of the equipment, but there are costs in the operations -- esp. in getting & keeping (with the costs) the trained personal required to run it. This would add to the already, seemly, month-to-month existence of JDS! Then, JDS does have an agreement to use a facility at the nearby (prev. Alexian Bros) hospital. Instead, I would continue to recommend periodic (e.g. quarterly) checks to JDS for their continued operations on a very austere budget. BTW: Also, I still highly recommend that you & your wife visit the JDS facility for a very heartening experience!

DISTRICT DEPUTY REPORT

My Brother Knights and Family,

Happy new year to you and your families! As we start this new Columbian Year 2010-11, let me introduce myself as your new District Deputy for District 27. My name is Tim Crews and I am a member of St Elizabeth Council 8747 in Milpitas. There have been some changes to the San Jose Chapter district structure that are taking place with this new Columbian Year.

The San Jose Chapter remains with 20 Councils, 19 of which are active. However, the State Council has reorganized the district structure and our Chapter grew from four districts to five. Some of the 20 Councils have been realigned within those districts.

This realignment is intended to level the workload of the district deputies. While having as many six Councils within a district is a heavy workload, it was not the largest. Last year there were districts in Southern California with as many as eight Councils under one DD! The State Council has taken steps to level things so that in general DD's have no more than five Councils. Here in San Jose all of the DD's have responsibility for four Councils. And it is important that even inactive or suspended Councils be accounted in the responsibilities of the DD.
